1. Opening of the meeting, adoption of the draft agenda and the minutes from the previous meeting

VG opens the meeting at 9AM and presents the agenda. Bureau approves agenda.

2. Events in 2016

a. Baltic regional gathering 20.-21.02.

Meeting took place, steered by JJ. LYMEC Bureau welcomes one more regional network where MOs can cooperate among each other.

b. <u>LYMEC/ELF workshop – Defending Europe, 17.-18.03.</u>

IC presents event. We have a good number of participants, but still some spots available. We need to have better mechanisms though to reach out to members of MOs, since it is not always easy to pass the information from LYMEC to International Officers and from there to members. We will create a Facebook group dedicated only to announcement of events. We will also ask IOs to forward events' announcements to their members. Regarding speakers, we are also with several confirmed speakers already.

c. Campaign training in Moscow

JJ sent a written report regarding this event; both Parnass and Yabloko are interested, and have about 40 participants available. JJ is contact with FNF to cooperate for this event. Financially LYMEC can provide for speakers.

3. Preparations for the Congress in Vienna

a. State of the Budget - incomes, donations, expenditures

IC presents the sates of income: 10k from ALDE Party, a variable amount of approximately 5K from ELF (both needing separate invoices). We need to fundraise to cover for diners/ farewell party.

Junos has provided already three offers, we are still looking for a more affordable offer.

b. Contract with the local organisers

DV has prepared the contract for signature.

c. Chairs of the congress and guests - local guests, PPYOs, ALDE (Party, Group),

VG proposes Slaven Klobucar and Srd Kisevic, former Secretary Generals. The third chair will be proposed by Junos. Bureau approves.

We will invite other PPYOs, ALDE Party and Group, and NEOS leadership.

d. Fringes - distribution of tasks

The conference will be an ELF seminar, with three sessions: one on political entrepreneurship, one on shared economy and one dinner with Angelika Mlinar.

We will also research the possibility of having speakers from Austrian entrepreneurship organisations.

SK suggests LYMEC to search for sponsorships among shared economy companies. DV will prepare a letter addressing them.

MY refers that ELSN wants an informal meeting. Bureau will arrange a meeting during the coffee break Saturday afternoon.

MY refers that CAP Working group would like to have a reporting time, VG answers that we have it as a Congress agenda point.

e. <u>Membership applications – announcements</u>

Both TLDE, Joves Liberals d'Andorra and Attistibai are interested in applying. Deadline for applications is in two weeks. Montenegrin Liberals might also be interested, as well as Slovenian, Bosnian and Kosovar. Nowocezna (Poland), ANO (Czech Republic), and Hungary must also be alerted to the possibility of applying.

f. <u>Elections - preparations</u>

Most positions in LYMEC are open: bureau (7), secretary general (1) ALDE Party

4. LYMEC IMS

a. Preparations of IMS elections

IC presents move to a new platform, simplyvoting.com. After the test vote, we had the highest participation in IMS elections (74 votes from 160) which indicates these elections should be more participated. Deadline for application of candidates is 1^{st} of March.

5. Finances

a. Spending plans for first 6 months of 2016.

DV presents state of finances. Congress represents the biggest expenses for this semester. Employer expenses should also be higher, given the end of contract with IC. Other expenses: bureau meetings (Skopje, Brussels); Baltic event, 20 of February; Moscow; Defence events; CAP working group; 40 years WG; ALDE Summer Academy.

b. <u>LYMEC Internal audit – pre-brief</u> Internal Audit will take place first weekend of March.

6. Press and campaigns

a. LYMEC TTIP campaign

JJ is looking for young entrepreneurs to tape videos in support of TTIP.

b. <u>Congress newspaper</u>

SH is preparing the newspaper. It will include sections on the topic of the congress, on elections and on Junos. We will also try to have the announcement of the Tallinn Congress.

7. Reports from the Working groups

a. <u>CAP Working group</u>

MY presents the conclusions of the skype meeting. Order of topics to be investigated was agreed as follows: Pillar 1; Pillar 2; Tariffs & Subsidies; Youth & Agriculture. Pillar 1 is to be researched and proposals for changes will be discussed at our nest Skype meeting in early March.

IC represented LYMEC at a debate in Brussels on youth unemployment.
