# 1) Situation in Ukraine and LYMEC actions - 30 minutes

- Including ALDE Party Leaders meeting feedback from AA

The content was explained during the meeting with our Ukrainian MOs on Monday where members were also present. It was a great opportunity for LYMEC to be present there. 3 Ukrainian members from ALDE were present. AA got the floor to close the meeting with the youth voice.

- We organised our second "voices from Ukraine" meeting

We sent out the outcomes and follow up actions to our members today.

- Renew Europe meeting on Ukraine

Full content of what LYMEC did about the Ukrainian war is summarised in a PDF to be sent out to Renew Europe ahead of the meeting on Wednesday with MEPs. Our 3 organisations will be present to give their accounts as part of the Task force on the Year of the Youth next Wednesday between 10 and 11.

- We will continue the "voices from Ukraine" in the coming weeks.

# 2) Congress - 1 hour:

- Bookings and logistics updates

\*Signature issues until now but we will have this finally settled in the coming days and move ahead with payments;

\*We asked for extra rooms and wait for the hotel to give us an invoice and settle contract for that second part;

Vesna Youth Movement still needs to invite us to a statutory meeting to have a valid application. DAS will follow up with them.

#### - MO fee exemption for Civil Forum Belarus

The Bureau decides to proceed and avoid invoicing our organisation in Belarus this year due to the fact that they just came back from suspension and we re-evaluate at the moment their involvement in the organisation.

#### - Freedom Fund requests

(a) Nasa Stranka Youth request for prepayment of travels to the Spring Congress:

- Refund will be done based on what was decided by the Bureau earlier
- We can't do prepayments

#### (b) EYU request for the Freedom Fund:

- 200 EUR/person will be granted by the Bureau

(c) LDLU and Ze!Molodizhka Ukraine will have the door open if they want to take the opportunity as well at the same rates as EYU.

#### - IMS delegation

Nicoleta Ciobanu resigned as IMS delegate and therefore her vote was transferred to Tim Robinson who will have two votes for this Congress.

\*We will provide refunds of **125 EUR** per delegation member based on the completion of the form and submission of the necessary documentation;

\*We will book the travels for BG, CL and MS soon and the rest will be booked after the elections at the last minute (no other option).
