



Movement of Free Citizens and European Liberal Youth:
Serbia must commit to a European path

A special emphasis during the discussion was on young people and their role and willingness to be part of change. LYMEC President and Austrian MP Ines Holzinger said that they will continue to support young liberals in Serbia and that their fight is also a European fight for a free and open society, justice and equality.
