# Bureau meeting Bratislava 15 Septembre 2019

## Wrap up Bratislava event (LH):

LH:

EUROPEAN LIBERAL YOUTH

- Getting the 3 external speakers was difficult for this event but we finally managed.
- One person didn't attend from Latvia, that means a no show fee.
- Participants were very responsive and came to take time to learn.
- Diversity and equality plan was mostly supported (5-6 editions) but Co-Presidency topic has to be discussed further.
- Co-Presidency debate has two main aspects:
  - A. Contingent on gender or something else?
  - B. One ticket or individuals running?
- Double evaluation was done on the spot (visual and printed questions) + questionnaire to be sent out after the event.

EM:

• YLM participants should be treated as Presidents and not just as participants. We should treat them at the hat they have. This initiative would work in a different setting, less with Presidents. This shouldn't be treated as any other event.

AA:

• Presidents were expecting to talk more about their own countries' situation/political realities. Peer exchange should be a bit more present and dealing with practices in their respective countries.

SH:

• Former event - Presidents were put in a moderation position. To be considered for next year too.

PCC:

• One of the benefits is the networking in such an event, the creation of a platform to keep in touch after the event.



# Every year we try to improve the concept and come up with something different. Goal is to inspire them and change something at local level.

Conclusion:

- More engagement between Presidents to exchange between each other.
- Tailor the session differently, led by the Presidents themselves.
- Suggestion regarding the diversity plan is to move on with the paper and have a Congress discussion.
- Gender policy should be considered in LYMEC.
- Co-Presidency should be discussed as well.
- Bureau has the task to offer a tool for more diversity in the organization.

Two sets of proposals were submitted for the election of the proposed Co-Presidency. Ticket or individual basis.

Proposal after discussion at the YLM and inputs from the Presidents: Recommendation for different gender in the co-presidency but not part of the proposal as such.

- a. Delete gender part in the proposal of statutory change (only co-presidency).
- b. Recommendation in the diversity plan to have it gender balanced.
- c. Bureau to reach out to the MO's to discuss it.

#### Update from ALDE Bureau (SH):

- a. H. Van Baelen running again for Presidency
- b. 2020: Council on 8-9 May in Bratislava + Congress on 25/26 October in Stockholm.

#### Finances (LH):

Budget 2020:

- 9000 extra money to put on staffing and ALDE Congress.
- Reducing in the Bureau communications to adjust to reality.
- EYF grant again? We should try to apply for the same concept.
- FNF partner event to take out.
- External budget for what's not going through our accounts.
- Another intern to be hired Spring time with new Bureau to focus on organizational issues and event planning start in March. *Recruitment starts in January*.
- Internal Audit end of September (last weekend)
- LH trying to technically solve issues with payments for last year that are still present in the book-keeping system. LH in touch with Xero support team.

### ALDE Congress (AA, BG):

- Delegation: 2 resolutions tabled and negotiated with other MOs
  - 1. Climate with strong Mos will pass.
  - 2. Transnational list IMS text is basically ours lobby for both.
- Not amending our own resolutions. All resolutions to be shared with the bureau
- Couple system in the delegation to help each other.
- Hearings with the candidate at the ALDE Congress will be planned by the officereception/coffee breaks (15 minutes meetings).
- Travel refund to delegates is confirmed (100 EUR/person).



#### IMS Event (EM):
