

**RULES OF ORGANISATION AND OPERATION**  
**YOUTH ALLIANCE OF LIBERALS AND DEMOCRATS**  
**TLDE**

**1. GENERAL DISPOSITIONS**

Art. 1

(1) The "Youth Alliance of Liberals and Democrats" - TLDE is the youth political structure established within the Alliance of Liberals and Democrats Party (ALDE) in accordance with art. 30 para. (1) and Art. 74 letter. d) of the ALDE Statute and it operates under cooperation with ALDE.

(2) The leadership functions acquired in the Youth Alliance of Liberals and Democrats are not equivalent to leadership positions acquired in a political party, except those held by members of the National Political Bureau of TLDE.

Art. 2

(1) The headquarters of the of TLDE are in Bucharest, Str. Zambaccian, No.17, Sector 1.

(2) The headquarters of local structures are at the corresponding premises of the subsidiaries of TLDE or ALDE.

(3) The youth structures can also organise other areas of work with the approval of the Executive Political Bureau of ALDE, respectively the Territorial Political Bureaus of ALDE.

Art. 3

TLDE logo is a flying bird surrounded by 12 yellow pentagram in an incomplete form of an ellipse with the text "TLDE, Youth Alliance of Liberals and Democrats" in the lower left, as seen in Appendix 4.

Art. 4

(1) Are allowed to be members of TLDE, ALDE members until the age of 35 years old who wish to activate within TLDE.

(2) In special cases, when one of TLDE members is over the age of 35 years, and is exercising a leadership mandate chosen within an election conference , he may exercise his belonging to TLDE until the expiration of that term.

## Art. 5

(1) The purpose of TLDE is to promote liberal ideas, democratic principles, of the programme, the activities and concerns of ALDE party among young people of Romania, to prepare, propose and support youngsters in ALDE structures, in central and local public administration as well and within the European Union structures, based on competence and free competition.

(2) In order to achieve this goal, the following means shall be employed :

- a) training activities of own members and other young people in the principles and values of democratic life, free market economy, liberalism;
- b) participation and organisation of specific actions and activities - liberal and democratic or youth;
- c) maintaining and developing relationships with similar organisations within the country and abroad, both political and apolitical;
- d) attracting into political life young people who are open to liberal and democratic ideas;
- e) campaigns for developing civic and political culture among young people,
- f) awareness campaigns for the youth on the right to vote and to be elected,
- g) all statutory means of action within the party.

## **CHAPTER 2. TLDE Organisation**

### Art. 6

TLDE is organised and operates at the local, county or sector of Bucharest, Bucharest municipality and national level, with political guidance and in cooperation with the corresponding organisation of ALDE.

## **Local level organisation**

### Art. 7

(1) Local TLDE organisations can be build in communes, towns and municipalities, where there are ALDE organisations according to art. 41 of this Regulation.

(2) The validation for their formation is done by the Territorial Political Bureaus of TLDE while informing the Territorial Political Bureaus of ALDE and validating their nominal composition by the National Politic Bureau of TLDE.

#### Art. 8

To build a local organisation there are necessary, at least:

- a) 5 members in the communes;
- b) 11 members in the cities;
- c) 25 members in the municipalities.

#### Art. 9

Local organisations of TLDE have the following leadership organisms:

- a) The General Assembly of the members of the organisation;
- b) The Local Political Bureau - commune, city, municipality.

#### Art. 10

The General Assembly of the Local members meets annually on a regular basis, following the convocation by the Local Political Bureau or following request of half plus one of the members of the organisation and has the following responsibilities:

- a) examines the local activity and approves their work programs;
- b) elects the members of the Local Political Bureau for a period of two years through simple majority vote.
- c) may analyse and decide to revoke members of the Local Political Bureau, following proposal of a third of its members, through simple majority vote.
- d) applies to the local level the required measures for achieving TLDE projects and party strategy;
- e) approves the TLDE candidates for local elections proposed by the Local Political Bureau of TLDE;
- f) debates and approves the activity report of the Local Political Bureau;
- g) appoints Delegations to the Territorial TLDE Branch Conference.

#### Art. 11

The president and the treasurer-coordinator Secretary approve the protocol of the General Assembly.

#### Art. 12 LOCAL POLITICAL BUREAU

(1) The Communal Political Bureau consists of 3-5 members and 1-2 substitutes with the following structure: president, vicepresident, secretary-treasurer coordinator and maximum 2 members.

(2) The City Political Bureau consists of 7-9 members and 2-3 substitutes with the following structure: president, 2 vicepresidents, secretary-treasurer coordinator and 3-5 members.

(3) The Municipal Permanent Bureau consists of 11-15 members and 4-5 substitutes with the following structure: President, 4-5 vicepresidents, secretary-treasurer coordinator and 5-8 members.

#### Art. 13

The Local Political Bureau meets twice a month and whenever necessary, convened by the president, the Territorial Political Bureau or following request by the simple majority of its members and has the following responsibilities:

- a) plans, leads, coordinates and monitors the activity of the local organisation in the interval between General Assemblies;
- b) prepares the candidate selection for local elections and submits it for approval to the General Assembly;
- c) forwards and supports the mandate received in the General Assembly;
- d) organises the necessary activities to perform their duties in accordance with the mandate received from the General Assembly;
- e) may submit proposals to the Territorial Political Bureau that may include: activities and projects, sanctions, co-opting new members to the Local Political Bureau;
- f) carries out the decisions of the higher governing bodies.

#### Art. 14

The President represents the structure within the local organisation of ALDE, in relations with other structures or persons, presides meetings of the Bureau and the General Assembly, coordinates the organisation's activities and signs the minutes of the Local Permanent Bureau of TLDE and of the General Assembly.

#### Art. 15

(1) The Secretary-Treasurer Coordinator is in charge of organising specific activities of TLDE according to the ALDE Statute and the decisions of the governing bodies of TLDE.

(2) The Secretary-Treasurer Coordinator presents a quarterly report including the situation of the local members organisation, the presence of the members to the meetings of the Local Political Bureau of TLDE and also the contributions situation according to the ALDE statute, TLDE rules and decisions of the superior hierarchical governing bodies.

(3) The Secretary-Treasurer Coordinator countersigns the minutes of Local Political Bureau and of the General Assembly.

#### Art. 16

According to the decisions of the present regulation, informal structures may be constituted, being on an inferior level to the one listed in art. 7 (neighbourhood, village and so on.).

## Organising of the territorial branch level

### Art. 17

In counties and in the sectors of Bucharest TLDE territorial branches are constituted including all local organisations.

### Art. 18

(1) Establishing of a territorial branch requires the following cumulative conditions:

- a) a minimum of 3 local organisations, including municipalities and also, mandatory condition, the county's capital.
- b) a minimum of 30 members with proof of payment of the fee, who participate at the constitution Conference.

(2) At Bucharest sector levels, branches of minimum 30 members will be established.

### Art. 19

Within 180 days of the territorial brach creation, establishing TLDE local organisations in the county's cities is mandatory.

### Art. 20

The governing bodies of the territorial branch are:

- a) The territorial branch Conference;
- b) The territorial Permanent Delegation;
- c) The Territorial Political Bureau.

### Art. 21

The territorial branch conference consists of:

- a) The Members of Territorial Delegation;
- b) The delegates of the local organisations, designated by the General Assemblies of local organisations, according to a representation rule previously established by the Territorial

Political Bureau of TLDE which will be calculated according to the number of those presents to the General Assembly and the results of the last local elections.

#### Art. 22

Conference territorial branch shall:

- a) adopts the daily work agenda;
- b) debates and adopts the political report presented by the president and the administrative report presented by the secretary;
- c) elects the president and the Territorial Political Bureau for a two year term;
- d) establishes the Youth Action Program for the branch, in accordance with the national one and ALDE's branch objectives.

#### Art. 23

(1) The Ordinary Conference meets every two years, convened by the TLDE Territorial Political Bureau, informing ALDE's Territorial Political Bureau and having the agreement of TLDE's National Political Bureau.

(2) The Extraordinary Conference meets by the proposal of the Territorial Political Bureau or by more than half of the local organisations proposal, informing ALDE's Territorial Political Bureau and having the agreement of TLDE's National Political Bureau.

(3) In both cases, the convocation can also be done by TLDE's National Political Bureau notifying ALDE's Territorial Political Bureau.

(4) In both cases, the convocation shall be done at least 30 days before the Congress, specifying the date, place and agenda of the meeting.

#### Art. 24

The Territorial Permanent Delegation consists of:

- a) members of the Territorial Political Bureau;
- b) presidents of the subordinated local organisations;
- c) MPs, MEPs, mayors, deputy mayors, county councillors, general and sector councillors of Bucharest, local councillors from municipalities of TLDE.

#### Art. 25

The Territorial Delegation meets every six months and whenever necessary, convened by the Territorial Political Bureau or by the more than half of its members.

## Art. 26

The Territorial Delegation Attributions are:

- a) analyses the activity of the local governing bodies and decides the necessary organisational measures;
- b) evaluates the development of territorial structures in terms of number of members, their activity and also the local representatives activity.
- c) designates the delegates to the Ordinary or Extraordinary TLDE Congress in accordance with the determined representation rule;
- d) approves the TLDE candidates for local and general elections, for the local public administration and submits proposals for approval to TLDE's National Political Bureau. Following validation by the BPN, the candidates list shall be forwarded to ALDE's Local Political Bureau, ALDE's Territorial Political Bureau or ALDE's Central Political Bureau.
- e) establishes the involvement modalities of local structures in drawing up programs and projects of local, county and national development.

## Art. 27

(1) The Territorial Political Bureau is the executive governing body at the county level for Bucharest's sectors, elected for a two year term and is composed of an odd number of members, between 17-21, 5-6 Substitutes and the following structure:

- a) president;
- b) 7-9 vicepresidents;
- c) 8-10 members;
- d) secretary-treasurer coordinator

(2) If in the respective county an ALDE Students Club is established, its president shall be a member by right of TLDE's Territorial Political Bureau.

(3) If in the respective county an ALDE Pupils Club is established, its president will have the status of permanent guest to TLDE's Permanent Territorial Bureau meetings with an advisory vote.

## Art. 28

(1) TLDE's Coordination Office of Bucharest is elected for a two year term, within Bucharest's Conference, and consists of:

- President
- Secretary-Treasurer Coordinator
- 2 Vicepresidents
- 6 presidents of the Bucharest territorial sector branches

- The President of the Students Club - ALDE Bucharest
- The President of the Pupils Club - *permanent guest with a consultative vote*

(2) Within TLDE's Coordinating Bucharest Bureau, shall be permanent invited guests, with voting right : municipal councillors, sectors councillors, the Mayor and / or the deputy mayor of the City, the Mayor and / or deputy Mayor of the sector, incumbent MPs who have their parliamentary office in one of the sectors of Bucharest.

(3) The decisions of TLDE's Coordination Bucharest Bureau are taken by simple majority, except the situation where only the members referred to in para. (1) would be attending the meeting, in which situations the decisions are taken by more than 7 votes.

#### Art. 29

(1) TLDEs Territorial Political Bureau meets twice a month and whenever necessary, convened by the President or by more than half of its members and has the following responsibilities:

- a) ensures the current management of the structure;
- b) respects and fulfils TLDE's National Political Bureau decisions and TLDE's Permanent Delegation decisions;
- c) monitors and evaluates the work of mayors, deputy mayors, county councillors and generals and local TLDE councillors as well;
- d) proposes TLDE candidates for decentralised services and for other positions as well and submits proposals to ALDE's Territorial Political Bureau;
- e) prepares a quarterly activity report and action plan and submits it to the general secretary in the attention of the Permanent TLDE Delegation;
- f) convenes the Conference of the territorial branch and the Permanent Territorial Delegation under art. 23 of this Regulation;
- g) elaborates the agenda of the Conference;
- h) establishes the representation norm to the TLDE territorial branch Conference;
- i) validates or invalidates the election results to local governing bodies;
- j) approves by vote of 2/3 of its members, the proposals of co-opting new members in the Territorial Political Bureau structure.
- k) in special situations, in case of deviation from the provisions of this Regulation and the ALDE Statute, it may decide to dissolve the Local Political Bureau or dismiss its president and establishes the organisations of interims in the TLDE local organisations, informing ALDE's Local Political Bureau, subject to approval by the TLDE's Territorial Delegation and TLDE's BPN validation;
- l) informs ALDE's Territorial Political Bureau about the election results in the subordinate local organisations;
- m) designates, between the vice-presidents, a provisional replacement of the unavailable president, for a period of maximum 3 months;



- n) proposes TLDE candidates for the county level elections and supports them in the appropriate ALDE organisms;
- o) pursues the fulfilment of the activities set by the Territorial Permanent Delegation;
- p) other duties provided by this Regulation.

(2) TLDE Territorial Permanent Bureau may assign specific attributions to other of its members.

#### Art. 30

The President represents the structure within ALDE's territorial branch, within TLDE, in relationship to other structures or persons, coordinates the branch activities, chairs meetings and signs the Permanent Territorial Bureau's minutes, as well as those of the Territorial Delegation and TLDE's territorial branch Conference and has the following specific responsibilities:

- a) presides over meetings of the organisations that he is participating in, informing its members about the work they perform;
- b) submits for approval to local governing bodies the measures for implementing the decisions of TLDE's BPE and BPN;
- c) proposes to the Territorial Political Bureau the appointment or removal of the members in the county level functions or in the Bucharest sector;
- d) proposes the co-opting of new members in the Territorial Political Bureau structure, in special situations.
- e) has a mandatory presence to Permanent Delegation meetings and answers to all of the TLDE central leadership's convocations;
- f) regularly informs the National Political Bureau and the National Permanent Delegation with data they require and informs territorial governing bodies about the branche's activity and important events in its field;
- h) is responsible for managing mobile goods and organisation's funds;
- j) leads political negotiations held at the territorial level with the teams he forms amongst members of the Territorial Political Bureau, respecting TLDE's BPE and BPN decisions.

#### Art. 31

**The Secretary-Treasurer Coordinator has the following specific attributions:**

- is responsible for the organisation of statutory activities, political and educational aspects of the territorial branch.
- presents a report to TLDE's Territorial Delegation including the attendance of TLDE Territorial Permanent Bureau members to the meetings.
- prepares and countersigns minutes of the Permanent Territorial Bureau, of Territorial Delegation and also of TLDE's territorial branch Conference.

- has the obligation to submit, under the coordination of TLDE branch president, the activity report to the general secretary, the action plan and complete database with new members validated in the previous month before by the 10th day of the ongoing month.

### **CHAPTER 3. Organising at the national level**

Art. 32

The National Structure includes all territorial branches of TLDE.

Art. 33

The governing bodies of the national structure are:

- a) TLDE's National Congress;
- b) TLDE's Permanent Delegation;
- c) TLDE's National Political Bureau.
- d) TLDE's Executive Political Bureau.

Art. 34

TLDE's National Congress is the supreme governing and decision forum of the Youth Alliance of Liberals and Democrats and consists of:

- a) Permanent Delegation members of TLDE;
- b) Delegates of the territorial branches, appointed according to a representation norm proposed by TLDE's National Political Bureau and approved by the TLDE's Permanent Delegation;
- c) county councillors, local councillors from the county capital, sector councillors and general councillors of Bucharest, mayors and deputy mayors of municipalities who are members of TLDE.

Art. 35

TLDE's National Congress has the following attributions:

- a) adopts the agenda;

- b) debates and adopts the report of TLDE's National Political Bureau presented by the president;
- c) debates and adopts the amending proposals of the Rules of functioning and organisation of TLDE submitted by ALDE's Permanent Delegation;
- d) elects TLDE's President for a two year term;
- e) elects TLDE's executive president for a two year term;
- f) elects TLDE's Prime Vice Presidents;
- g) elects TLDE's National Political Bureau vicepresidents, for a two year term.
- h) elects TLDE's National Political Bureau members, for a two year term.
- i) debates and adopts the specific action Program of TLDE;
- j) other duties provided by this Regulation.

#### Art. 36

(1) TLDE's ordinary National Congress is held every two years, convened by TLDE's Permanent Delegation to TLDE's National Political Bureau proposal and informing ALDE's Central Political Bureau.

(2) TLDE's Extraordinary National Congress is held being convened by the Permanent Delegation, by proposal of more than half of the members of TLDE's National Political Bureau or at the request of more than half of the permanent territorial delegations subject to the approval of ALDE's Central Political Bureau.

(3) In both cases, the notice shall be at least 45 days in advance, specifying the date, place and agenda of the meeting.

#### Art. 37

TLDE's Permanent Delegation consists of:

- a) members of the National Political Bureau;
- b) the presidents of the Territorial Political Bureaus;
- c) the president and vicepresidents of the Coordination Bureau of Bucharest;
- d) the general secretary and regional secretaries for the 8 development regions (defined by Law no. 315/2004);
- e) MPs and TLDE MEPs;
- f) the mayors of municipalities and of Bucharest's sectors;
- e) if a member of the Territorial Political Bureau is found in the National Political Bureau, the Territorial Permanent Delegation designates through simple majority vote, amongst the vicepresidents of the Territorial Political Bureau, a substitute for the representation in the Permanent Delegation.

## Art. 38

TLDE's Permanent Delegation has the following attributions:

- a) provides national structure's leadership between TLDE's National Congresses;
- b) convenes and proposes the agenda of TLDE's National Congress by the National Political Bureau's proposal;
- c) approves the representation norm to TLDE's National Congress proposed by the Commission for the Establishment of the Representation Norm and informs the ALDE's National Political Bureau in this concern;
- d) monitors the implementation of ALDE's political Program in the youth domain;
- e) coordinates and evaluates how all TLDE branches fulfil the objectives arising from the strategy and political programs of TLDE and ALDE in the youth domain;
- f) validates the interims established by TLDE's National Political Bureau;
- g) approves TLDE associations with similar structures from the country and abroad;
- h) validates the general secretary and the regional secretaries, approved by TLDE's National Political Bureau;
- i) other attributions provided by this Regulation.

## Art. 39

(1) TLDE's Permanent Delegation meets quarterly, or whenever required, convened by the National Political Bureau.

(2) TLDE Permanent Delegation meets in extraordinary meeting convened by the National Political Bureau or at the request of half plus one of the members composing it.

## Art. 40

(1) The National Political Bureau is the deliberative political body, elected by uninominal secret vote by the TLDE Congress, for a two year term and is composed of:

- President
- Executive President
- 2 Prime-Vicepresidents
- 18 Vicepresidents
- General Secretary
- 27 Members
- 11 Substitute Members
- President of CS-TLDE

- President of TLDE-Rural
- President of the Business Men's Club of TLDE
- President of TLDE ON-LINE
- International Officer

(2) At the National Political Bureau meetings participate without voting right regional secretaries for the 8 development regions.

#### Art. 41

National Political Bureau has the following attributions:

- a) ensures the current management of TLDE;
- b) decides and submits for approval to TLDE's Permanent Delegation the convocation of the TLDE ordinary National Congress and its agenda.
- c) convenes TLDE's National extraordinary Congress under this Regulation.
- d) monitors and evaluates the work of MPs and TLDE representatives in central public administration;
- e) approves and dismisses the Secretary General, with the vote of half plus one of the members of TLDE National Political Bureau, to the TLDE President's proposal or the proposal of half plus one of the BPC members.
- f) approves and revokes regional secretaries, with the vote of half plus one of the members of TLDE National Political Bureau, by the proposal of the Secretary General in consultation with the vicepresidents that holds regional attributions, related, or by the proposal of half plus one of the BPC members
- g) approves and revokes the appointment of the international officer with the vote of half plus one of the members of TLDE National Political Bureau, to the President's proposal or the proposal of half plus one of the BPC members.
- h) in case of approval for establishing a TLDE local organisation, validates the nominal composition of its management structure;
- i) proposes for validation to TLDE Permanent Delegation the regional secretaries for the 8 regions (delimitated by Law no. 315/2004) (Annex 1),
- j) validates or invalidates the election results of the management organisms at the territorial level;
- k) validates the number of delegates determined by TLDE Bucharest Coordinating Bureau for the General Assembly that will elect the President, Vicepresidents and the Coordinator Secretary of the Coordination Bureau of TLDE Bucharest;
- l) approves and revokes the appointment of interim Presidents, with the vote of half plus one of its members, by the TLDE President's proposal or the proposal half plus one of the members of BPN and also the offices they support, that will have an executive role together, until the moment of the validation by the D.P.

- m) approve and revoke the appointment of the President of the Business Men's Club of TLDE, by the vote of half plus one of the members of the TLDE National Political Bureau, by the President's proposal or the proposal of half plus one of the members of the BPC.
- n) proposes the establishment of a Committee to establish the Norm of Representation of the delegates in TLDE Congress.
- o) approves the proposed decisions by the Executive Political Bureau.
- p) other attributions provided by this Regulation.

#### Art. 42

The National Political Bureau meets monthly and whenever necessary, convened by TLDE's President or by request of half plus one of its composing members.

#### Art. 43

The functions within TLDE's National Political Bureau are not incompatible with other functions held at TLDE and ALDE level.

#### Art. 44

TLDE's President exercises leadership and coordination activities of the organisation at a national and international level and has the following attributions:

- a) leads the meetings of the National Political Bureau and the Permanent Delegation;
- b) represents the structure within ALDE and in the relations with other national or international structures or people;
- c) signs the minutes of the Central Political Bureau;
- d) makes statements on behalf of the organisation
- e) convenes and chairs the meetings of the Executive Political Bureau, National Political Bureau and the Permanent Delegation and any other governing bodies of the party that he is taking part;
- f) proposes to the National Political Bureau the appointment of TLDE's Secretary General
- g) proposes to the Central Political Bureau the appointment or revocation of the executive secretaries and of the international relations secretary;
- h) may invite any person to participate in the debates of the National Political Bureau and Permanent Delegation's meetings.
- i) establishes the domain responsibilities for the prime-vicepresidents, the vice-presidents and Central Political Bureau members.

## Art. 45

(1) The Political Executive Bureau is an operating body within the National Political Bureau and ensures TLDE's operational management between meetings of the National Political Bureau, being invested with any of the Central Political Bureau attributions.

(2) The Political Executive Bureau consists of:

- President
- Executive President
- 2 Prime-Vicepresidents
- 18 Vicepresidents
- Secretary General
- President of CS-TLDE
- President of TLDE-Rural
- President of the Business Men's Club of TLDE
- President of TLDE ON-LINE
- International Officer
- President of TLDE Bucharest

## Art. 46

Political Executive Bureau has the following specific attributions:

- adopts and monitors the implementation of measures to fulfil the decisions of the governing bodies of the party at the national level;
- elaborates and proposes to the Central Political Bureau and to the Permanent Delegation the strategy and the program of TLDE activities
- coordinates and evaluates how all the territorial branches fulfil the objectives that arise from TLDE's strategy and program of activities
- solves the current organisational problems;
- proposes and applies sanctions to members of the party in accordance with the Statute.
- negotiates political agreements within the limits of the mandate approved by the Permanent Delegation
- proposes candidates to the National Political Bureau for the local, general and european elections, within the limits of the mandate received from the ALDE and depending on qualifications and professional experience

- elaborates and proposes decisions that will be subject to approval by TLDE's BPN concerning the new ways of co-opting members in BPN structure. (New members must propose ideas for national projects that will fulfil conditions settled by TLDE's BPE)

TLDE's Executive President has the following attributions:

- Is in charge along with the regional vicepresident of solving problems of functionality from territorial branches;
- In case of the president's unavailability for more than three months, the executive president takes his attributions.
- Monitors the implementation of BPN's decisions in the branches, compliance of the provisions from the Statute and from this Regulation;
- Leads the Commission that establishes the norm of delegates to the National Congress in accordance with BPN's decisions
- Leads, in the absence of the president, the meetings of the Executive Political Bureau, the National Political Bureau and the Permanent Delegation;
- Other powers resulting from this Regulation.

Art. 46

Vicepresidents and the National Political Bureau members receive specific attributions set by the National Political Bureau at the President's proposal.

Art. 47

The Secretary General has the following attributions:

- a) directs the activity of the Secretariat and TLDE's Treasury
- b) ensures the communication between the National Political Bureau and territorial branches;
- c) quarterly submits a report within the Permanent Delegation that presents the presence of TLDE's National Political Bureau members at the meetings;
- d) proposes the appointment and/or the revocation of the regional secretaries.
- e) coordinates the activity of the regional secretaries;
- f) signs the minutes of the Central Political Bureau, of the Permanent Delegation and TLDE's National Congress as well.



Art. 48

Regional Secretaries for the 8 regions (defined by Law no. 315/2004) (Annex 1) have the following responsibilities:

- a) have the right to vote at meetings of TLDE's Permanent Delegation
- b) ensure communication between the Secretary General and territorial branches from the development region that they are responsible of;
- c) coordinate the activity of the secretary treasurer-coordinators of the territorial branches from the development region that they are responsible of;
- d) participate at National Political Bureau meetings without voting right.

Art. 50

The International Officer has the following attributions:

- a) represents TLDE in the international relation with the youth organisations;
- b) the international officer coordinates the external activity of TLDE in relation with IFLRY, LYMEC, ISEEL and any other external organisations that TLDE is part of;
- c) ensures communication with the similar youth organisations from other countries;
- d) proposed for adoption to TLDE's National Political Bureau resolutions and positions that TLDE may have it in its activity abroad;
- e) proposes and develops with TLDE's National Political Bureau the timetables of TLDE's external activity;
- f) manages the organisation of TLDE's events of external nature;
- g) constantly informs TLDE's National Political Bureau and TLDE branches about the events, seminars and any other external activities;

Art. 51

Within TLDE the following subordinate structures may operate their activity:

- a) TLDE's Specialised Commissions, subordinated by a BPN TLDE vicepresident;
- b) TLDE's businessmen club
- c) TLDE's students club
- d) TLDE's pupils club
- e) TLDE Rural
- f) TLDE online

g) other structures that will be created by TLDE

Art. 52

The structures mentioned in Art. 51 operate on the basis of their organization and operation regulations approved by TLDE's Permanent Delegation.

### **3. Penalties**

Art. 53

The sanctions are applied in accordance with ALDE's Statute and its Rules of application, including the provision according to which a member will be excluded by right, if he or she doesn't pay his/her fee for 6 months, inexcusably.

Art. 54

(1) unjustified absence Local Political Bureau, Territorial or BPC's member to a number of three consecutive ordinary meetings leads to the exclusion from position.

2) The absence, motivated or unmotivated, of a Local Political Bureau's member, National or Territorial to half of regular meetings held within twelve consecutive months leads to exclusion from position.

(3) Do not constitute unexcused absences, those caused by illness, accidents, family reasons, public representations and electoral campaign.

#### TANSITIONAL and FINAL PROVISIONS

Art. 55

The provisions of this Regulation concerning TLDE's internal elections, regarding the governing bodies at all levels come into force as of 01/01/2017.

Art. 56

Leading National Transitional structures up to the elections consist of:

- a) Congress (General Assembly of the delegates of party members)
- b) Permanent Delegation

- c) National Political Bureau
- d) Executive Political Bureau
- e) 2 Co-presidents

Art. 57

(1) The following national leadership structures, namely the National Permanent Delegation, the National Political Bureau and the Executive Political Bureau will be composed of an equal number of members from the two merging organisations.

(2) A number of necessary representatives will be added to the composition of the national structures mentioned above, to achieve an equal number of different representatives from the respective structure of each political party .

Art. 58

**Composition of the Permanent Delegation consists of:**

- TLR's National Permanent Delegation
- TC's National Council

Art. 59

**Composition of the National Political Bureau consists of:**

- TLR's Central Political Bureau
- TC's Political Bureau

Art. 60

**Composition of the Executive Political Bureau consists of:**

- TLR's Executive Political Bureau
- TC's Central Executive Bureau

#### Art. 61

The co-presidents are the presidents of the former Reformist Liberal Youth and former Youth Conservatory.

#### Art. 62

In all cases, in case of a vacant position of member of a governing body, at any level, that position will be filled by co-option among the members of the organisation from which resulted the member who is occupying that position.

#### Art. 63

The lists of TLDE candidates proposed for the local, general or European elections are validated by TLDE's National Political Bureau.

#### Art. 64

Before the election day, the National Permanent Delegation will not be able to convene the Extraordinary Congress without the written consent of the two Copresidents to the national level.

#### Art. 65

All the provisions of the Regulation which contravene the transitional measures come into force after the date of the first elections within TLDE and after their organisation the transitional measures articles will be repealed.

#### Art. 66

All the annexes of this Regulation are part of this Regulation.
