REQUEST for MEMBERSHIP FEE WRITE-OFF

Dear LYMEC, dear Congress,

European Youth of Ukraine, the liberal youth non-governmental organization, is addressing to you with the request to kindly write-off the debt for membership fee for 2016 completely.

We would kindly ask you to consider the following:

1) EYU does not have no permanent office. For the moment we do not have any political partner, that is liberal, and has representation in the Parliament;

2) Every member of the organization is 100% non-paid volunteer, including board members;

3) There is no state funding in the budget of EYU. Considering tough economical and political situation, even state funding for projects and events, organised by Ukrainian NGOs, is remarkably low. Also the point is in exchange rate, that increased three times and every payment in Euros became extremely expensive for us;

4) We do not have regular membership fee for our members; when attending international events as EYU representatives, activists pay the participation fee on their own, in addition to the work they do voluntarily for EYU.

Regarding financial instability of EYU and difficult situation in the country especially last year, we ask you to write-off our membership fee for 2016.
