Here is our request for the annulation of our debt. I answered the question right here:

- Whether an organisation has a permanent office and its size;
Yes, a room in the center of the capital city, Bern
- Whether an organisation has permanent staff and its number;
Yes, 1 Secretary General and 1 or 2 interns (depends on money and campaigns)
- Whether an organisation has state funding;
Yes, but soon not anymore, as liberal party, we asked the parlement to vote an amendment in order to stop state funding to political parties. This means we will have a big whole in our budget, but we think it is a good thing.
- The number of paying members of the organisation;
0, our members don't pay any fees to us
- The level of service provided for international work;
1 international officer. JFS pays the trip and the participation for LYMEC and ALDE Congresses. JFS has a delegate in the delegation of FDP Schweiz for ALDE
- The financial situation and the ability to pay;
Okay for now, always depends on campaigns. But we have elections next year and big campaigns for referendums coming up in November already. (In Switzerland, the whole population is invited to vote on referendums or constitutional amendments 4 times a year)
- The state of the banking system in the country of registration of the organisation.
