

Proposal for Membership Fees 2019

In this document, the LYMEC Bureau proposes the membership fees for 2019. The membership fees of LYMEC were adjusted 2017. This year, however, the Bureau proposes a minor increase of the membership fees for individual members. For full and associate members, the fees remain the same.

Full Membership Fees

The bureau proposes the following, in line with the membership fees of 2018:

Proposed Full Member fee: 200 euros + 0,06 euros per member, maximum 1200 euros

The in line with this years fees, the Bureau proposes a 1 200 euro cap, which would be in place from approximately 16 700 members onwards. Only one of our organisations currently has more than 16 700 members. If the cap would not be added, the fee of that organisation would skyrocket.

Associate Membership Fees

LYMEC has several Associate Members. According to our statutes, those organisations have mostly the same rights as full member organisations, but they cannot vote and they cannot propose candidates for Bureau. Since Associate Members don't have any voting rights, the fee is not based on membership, but fixed. The Bureau proposes to keep the existing fee.

Proposed Associate Member fee: 175 euros

Individual Membership Fees

The LYMEC Bureau proposed to raise the fees for becoming a member of the Individual Membership Section (IMS), seeing as this sum has not been adjusted in many years despite inflation and development of the IMS. The intention is to provide a welcome pack for new Individual Members in 2019.

Proposed annual IMS fee: 15 euros

Proposed 5-year IMS fee: 50 euros

Proposed lifetime membership (valid until 35 years): 100 euros
