Request for the annulation of our debt

Dear LYMEC Congress, dear members of the bureau,

After being completely inactive in the Liberal Youth Movement of the European Community (LYMEC) during a few years and after not having paid any member fee, the delegates of Jungfreisinnige Schweiz (JFS) decided on June 16 2018, to remain member of LYMEC with proviso that our debt (member fees from 2015 to 2017) will be annulated. Consequently, we are formally asking the Congress to accept to cancel our debt.

In addition, JFS paid its member fee for 2018 (€ 425.90), which represents almost 50% of the debt, without enjoying advantages of LYMEC, e.g. right to vote during the last spring congress.

According to our delegates and the board, it is important for JFS to be part of an international structure as LYMEC in order to create a network, but also to be able to defend the interests of Switzerland in the European community. Therefore, JFS desires to get more involved in your organisation and to attend actively congresses and other events.

Our International Officer, Michel Tschank, is going to attend the autumn congress in Vilnius and will be ready to explain the situation of JFS and answer questions from the Congress.

We are looking forward to having a better and more active collaboration with LYMEC.
