We have a partnership agreement with the Progresívne Slovensko movement, thanks to which we are its member organization, and an inside platform of said movement. As well as that, we cooperate with other youth and political organizations. Through IRI and NDI we have started cooperating with other centrist central-European youth organizations, for example Young Modern from Poland, Young ANO from Czech Republic.
