Your registration can be made online or via a registration form and is binding. If not stated otherwise in the description of the event, you will receive a binding confirmation of your registration at least on May 31<sup>st</sup> for the #POLITATHON - POLITICAL HACKATHON. During the event participants may take photographs and sound recordings for documentation purposes, also for publication on the Internet. By registering, participants agree that they will be displayed on such transmissions.

In case of insufficient registrations (less than 25 persons) or force majeure, we reserve the right to cancel the event. We will inform you as soon as possible about a cancelation. Any payments made will be refunded promptly.

If the event requires a participation fee it will be due with the binding confirmation or invoice sent by us. If you have indicated at the registration to pay in cash at the venue, the amount will be due only at the beginning of the event.
