Uppreisn is the youth wing of Viðreisn. Uppreisn has a representative in the mother party's board, parliamentary group meetings and Reykjavík city council group meetings. Uppreisn acts as a check and balance on the mother party's activities and decisions but operates independantly and is unafraid of publicly challenging the party's policies. Uppreisn is a member of the Icelandic Youth Council (a full member of the European Youth Forum).

Uppreisn has no membership fees but relies on revenue from the sale of merchandise and occasional funding from Viðreisn per request. Viðreisn, as with all other eligable political parties in Iceland, receives State funding according to Icelandic law. The annual turnover is approx. 150.000 ISK.
