On behalf of the LYMEC Bureau, I propose to the LYMEC Spring Congress in Skopje to suspend the membership of the following member organisations in LYMEC in order to

- avoid the said organisations from accumulating further debt due to unpaid fees to LYMEC,
- while the LYMEC Bureau is given further suspense to investigate the future status of the said organisations.

**Civil Forum Belarus** (debt, not responding to Bureau and office contact)

**Musavat Youth Organisation** (minor debt, not responding to Bureau and office contact)

**Youth Forum of AKR** (haven't attended LYMEC events since over two years, debt from 2019)

**European Youth Movement of Ukraine** (debt from 2019, no attendance since membership in 2017)

**UDI Jeunes** (debt, not responding to Bureau and office contact)

On behalf of the LYMEC Bureau I am also suggesting to disaffiliate **TLDE Romania** due to the organisation failing to respond to correspondence from the Bureau on their membership in LYMEC. Also, the organisation has a debt to LYMEC. TLDE last attended our Autumn Congress in Vilnius in 2018.
